

MILITARY RETIREMENT, SBP AND OTHER BENEFITS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that, pursuant to 10 U.S. Code 1078a, the Defendant will cooperate in obtaining medical coverage for the Plaintiff under the Continued Health Care Benefit Program (CHCBP), executing or producing any documents and doing all things necessary to ensure her eligibility for same. He is ordered to provide to Plaintiff a share of his military retired pay pursuant to this order, 10 U.S. Code 1078a and 10 U.S. Code 1408, in the amount of \$1.00 (one dollar) per month, payable directly to the Plaintiff by Defendant, and he is also ordered to provide Survivor Benefit Plan coverage for the Plaintiff in the amount of \$300 per month, the statutory minimum for said former-spouse coverage, by immediately executing DD Form 2656 and DD Form 2656-1, and transmitting them to the proper addresses (as shown thereon) when complete. This court has jurisdiction over the parties and the division of military retired pay and of allocation of former-spouse SBP coverage through the consent of the parties. This order is entered for division of the Defendant's military pension, pursuant to the Uniformed Services Former Spouses' Protection Act, 10 U.S.C. 1408, and pursuant to the federal statutes governing the allocation of the Survivor Benefit Plan, 10 U.S.C. 1447-1455. The Plaintiff has been advised as to her ineligibility if she remarries before age 55, and she is responsible for taking all further steps – once the terms of this order are implemented – in applying for and obtaining CHCBP coverage, paying the premium, and keeping the Program administrator informed as to her marital status.
